Lindita Lati holds the title of Professor in the field of Accounting from the University of Tirana. In 2001, she finished her Ph. D in Economics at the Staffordshire University, United Kingdom.

Currently, she's serving as the Dean of the Faculty of Economic Sciences at the Mediterranean University of Albania. Apart from her academic responsibilities, Prof. Lati, has contributed significantly to the governance and oversight of financial affairs. She has previously held key positions such as Deputy Chairman and General Director at the Supreme State Audit, showcasing her expertise in ensuring fiscal accountability and transparency. Having been confirmed by the vote of the Parliament, Mrs. Lati held two mandates as Head of the Competition Authority from 2006 to 2016. During the 2004 - 2010 years, Mrs. Lati served as a Member of the National Accounting Council. With an extensive academic background, Lindita has been an integral part of the Faculty of Economics at the University of Tirana, both as a full-time and part-time faculty member from 1990 to 2019. Additionally, she served as the Deputy Rector of the University of Tirana from 2004 to 2006. Lindita has contributed to the academic community with textbooks, monographs, articles, and other scientific papers in areas such as: public auditing, competition, and accounting. She holds the distinguished position of a European Union senior expert in the fields of public auditing and competition.
